



Cheapside CE Primary School New Curriculum 2014

From September 2014 there will be a new national curriculum in place which allows schools a little more flexibility in what they teach. We have worked together with the two other Church schools in the Ascot Cluster to develop a new curriculum.

The curriculum will follow a thematic approach with six broad themes covered across the whole school in an academic year. These themes are:

Where in the World?

Bright Sparks

Heroes and Villains

What's cooking?

Animal Magic

The Big Race

Literacy and Numeracy will continue to be taught discretely but with writing links to all the themes being followed.

We have introduced a new scheme of work to support the teaching of ICT and, during the course of the year, we will be exploring a range of additional resources to supplement our existing teaching materials to deliver the New Curriculum.

The school will continue to publish further details of the curriculum on a termly basis for each class in our newsletters and on the website.

Assessment Arrangements

The school will continue to report progress to parents and attainment against age related expectations during Parent Meetings throughout the year. The school will provide one long report per academic year which will include an overview of progress and attainment, as well as results from any national tests.
