Laptop Competition

Last Friday we emailed a letter announcing the exciting news that, following on from our laptop appeal run by Kate Anstis, we have been able to purchase 35 laptops for class use.

We are launching a competition inviting children in each class to design at home a picture/image that reflects a sponsor's company name and the winning 3/4 designs from each class will be used to create a montage 'wallpaper' for the school's suite of laptops.

Children whose designs are chosen will have the opportunity to meet with the sponsors on 26th May and demonstrate how they use laptops to support their learning in school.

Each class is being given 3/4 different sponsors. Each child is then being invited to choose one logo from the 3/4 logos their class has been given and to create a design that reflects its general theme. They can use pen, paint or pencil or a digital design. So, for example, an entry based on the racecourse may include horses.

With each sponsor/employee matched funding below, there is a brief outline of its theme to help the children create their picture/image.

– A design that shows travel to weird and wonderful destinations around the world.

Phil Norman for employee matched funding from Microsoft – A design showing Information Technology.

Adam Davey – A design that shows 'What daddies do!'
