Our Values for the Month

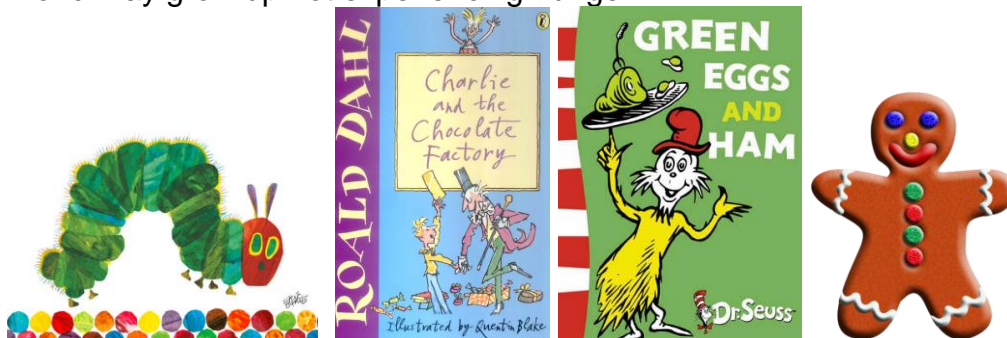
For the month of March, the season of the Church is Lent and our values are Honesty and Responsibility.
