

Year 1 Spelling Lists for 2nd half Summer Term 2016

Please help your child to learn the spelling rules below by practicing a little each day. We encourage the children to look at the word, cover it, write it, say it and check it. This half term the focus of our spelling has changed and is more about learning spelling rules rather than individual phonemes.

(Dates are the weeks that the lists are being worked on, the testing will be on the Friday at the end of that week. Please note that we will be asking the children to write the words in a sentence dictated by us.)

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Common exception words - revisit and revise

Last half term we tested all the children on the 45 common exception words and your child will know how many of those words they spelt correctly and have a personal list of those they need to work on. Please help your child to revise those words they are not spelling correctly. We will continue to revisit these words in random order each week. We will retest these words again during the **week beginning 11th July**.

All the children need to continue to work on spelling the number names to twenty and the months of the year, so please keep working on these as well. We will be testing these again in the last week of June (wk beginning 20th June - number names and the wk beginning 27th June - months of the year
