



Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 16/05/16

This week we have looked at the story of The Snail and the Whale. We have been making simple maps to illustrate the journey of the snail and the whale and labelling the key human and physical features. We have also written postcards from the snail about the journey and what he saw.

In phonics we have continued to work on CCVC words and the reading of the tricky words have, like, come and some.

In maths we have been working on counting in 10s, 2s and 5s. We have also been investigating what makes a number odd or even.

The children have enjoyed making snail pictures in the style of Matisse and they have also made snail trail paintings using string.

Next Thursday we will be going on a walk around the local area looking at the different physical and human features of the local environment.

Home learning challenge ...

Maths

Group objects in sets of 2, 5 or 10 and arrange and label them to make a number line. Take a picture of your number line and send it in.

EXT: once your child has made and labelled their number line, can you take a number label away and challenge your child to work out the missing number or you could muddle up the number labels for your child to rearrange.
