This week we have focused our work around the story of 'The Magic Porridge Pot'. We have enjoyed a range of activities linked to the story including, retelling the story through role play and making our own porridge pots using papier mache. In maths we have been measuring capacity and weight using uniform non-standard measures and direct comparison. In phonics we have been focusing on the sounds /ar/ and /oo/, please support your child in reading and spelling words containing these sounds.

This Week's Home Learning Challenge:

This week we would like the children to have the opportunity to experiment with capacity by direct comparison.

1. Select a variety of containers and support your child in finding which hold the most and the least. You could extend your child by setting them the challenge of ordering the containers by their capacity. Your child could draw or photograph their work as a record for their learning journey.
