This week we have been focusing on stories with a moral. We have looked at The Boy Who Cried Wolf, The Lost Sheep and a traditional tale from Asia, The Dog and The Elephant. The children have enjoyed listening to the stories and we have focused on speaking and listening and explaining what we can learn from the stories. We have linked our maths work and art to these stories.

In phonics we have been writing short captions which contain CCVC words. Our phonics has been on applying phonics to caption and sentence writing.

We enjoyed our walk around the local area where our focus was on Understanding the World. We were getting the children to look at features in their own immediate environment and all the children enjoyed heading off with their spotter sheet to see what they could see on our walk. Back in class we had a go at producing a map of our walk where we drew on some of the features we spotted.

After half term we will be focusing on plants and growing. The focus will be on observing changes as plants grow.

We will be doing a mini topic on our first week back on The Queen. If you have any resources or artefacts that you think might enhance that topic then please send them in with your child. We will be working towards a whole school street party at the end of that week to celebrate The Queen's 90th birthday.
