This week we have looked at the story of The Rainbow Fish. We have been retelling the story with puppets and sequencing the story. We have been collaging our own fish and writing about our own sea creature. We have also been researching facts about ocean creatures.

In phonics we have been continuing with reading and writing CVCC words and making sure the children can hear and represent the vowel sounds and all the consonants in these words.

In maths we have been looking at capacity and exploring the capacity of different containers using water and rice. We have also investigated sharing and have shared scales between 2 and 4 fish. We have begun to talk about numbers we can share equally and numbers we cannot.


