OWLS CLASS VISIT TO THE VICTORIAN SCHOOL ROOM AND READING MUSEUM – TUESDAY, 13 DECEMBER 2016

As part of our study of Victorian Times, Owls Class will be visiting The Victorian School Room and Reading Museum on Tuesday, 13 December 2016.

The cost for the day will be £13.65 per child which includes the cost of the coach hire.

The coach will leave Cheapside at 9:15 am **promptly** and return in time for usual collection at 3:15 pm. Each child will require a packed lunch and a drink (a simple bread and cheese lunch in a paper bag or wrapped in cloth would be in keeping with the Victorian experience!) and will need to be dressed as a 'Victorian child' for the day.
