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Common exception words - revisit and revise

This half term we will be revisiting all the common exception words that we have been asking the children to spell this year. All of these words have been set as spellings over the course of the year so we are using this half term to revise them all and to ensure your child can accurately spell these words in the dictation test and in their writing. We are not assigning words to specific weeks as you should now only need to refresh knowledge so words can be selected randomly and you can work on the words that your child finds difficult. During the final week we will test all 45 words in a written spelling test.
