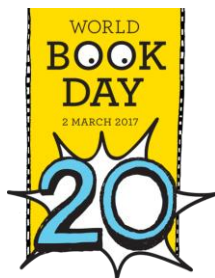
### Our Value for the Month

### A Huge Thank You!

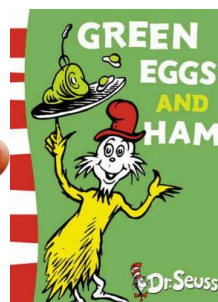
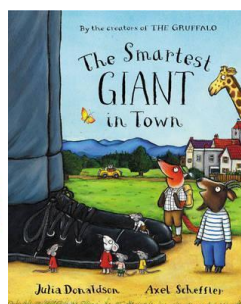
