This week we have been reading the story 'Owl Babies' We have talked about the story and discussed the characters and settings. We have talked about how the characters might have felt and used speech bubbles to record what they said. We created pictures of our favourite part of the story and labelled the characters and setting. Our role play area is now the owl baby tree house.

In maths we have been continuing to focus on counting and ordering and on Friday the children had a go at counting and sorting Pudsey Bear's spots!

In phonics we have now introduced all the single letter sounds and the tricky words the, to, no, go, I, into. We are continuing to work on blending sounds to read and write CVC words. The last letter introduced this week were f, l, j, v, w and x if you wanted to work on reading and writing these letters at home.

We have also continued to talk about the changes associated with autumn and we have begun to learn the months of the year associated with each season.

Over the next few weeks the home learning will be to learn the words for our Christmas Production entitled 'Christmas with the Aliens!' We will be sending home the words for our songs each week and we would really appreciate it if you could help your child to learn the words so that they feel confident to sing and perform them on the day. We will be sending home new songs each week, the songs for this week are included with this newsletter.
