This week we have been focusing on the story 'Oliver's Vegetables'. We have used the story as a stimulus for lots of maths activities. The children have been weighing different fruits and vegetables and they all really enjoyed our investigation - Is the longest carrot always the heaviest?

In literacy we used potatoes to create our own Mr Potato Head and then to write some sentences about him or her! The creations were fantastic and the children were very excited to take them home! We have also talked about the parts of a plant we eat and have tried to see if we could work out which part of the plant some vegetables came from.

We are continuing with our bean diaries and the beans are growing brilliantly. The children have really enjoyed watching them grow.

In phonics we have been revising the 'oa' sound and spelling the phase 3 tricky words.

Just a quick reminder that our Forest School visit to The Marist happens on Wednesday 24th May. The children will not need to bring book bags in school just a water bottle! A text has been sent out reminding you of the clothing your child needs to wear.
