Over the past 2 weeks we have continued our Percy the Park Keeper Theme. The children have had a go at drawing a picture from the story and writing a caption applying their phonics.

We have all really enjoyed Christmas art activities and the children have made some fantastic decorations which will be displayed in school before they find their way home to you in time for Christmas! The children are really enjoying the Christmas post-office and we have some great examples of independent writing.

Work continues on counting to 20, recognising numerals and ordering numbers. We have also been carrying out 1-1 maths assessments with your children.

In phonics we have been consolidating all the sounds we have learnt this term, and on recognising **no, go, into, the, to, he, she, I** These are words that the children cannot sound out and will need to learn to recognise and read these words on sight. Please help your child at home to recognise and read these words on sight. It might be useful to write these words out on card to make some simple flash cards. You could stick them up somewhere prominent so that your child can look at them on a regular basis. Thank you.

If your child has a reading book, please could you ensure that they have their reading book and reading record in their book bags everyday so that we can hear them read in class. Thank You
