This week we have been basing our learning around the We're going on a bear hunt. We have been acting out the story trying to remember and recall descriptive words and phrases and repeated refrains. We have also been using instruments and music to add sound effects to our story telling. We have drawn journey maps of the story, been on a sensory walk and used this idea to plan and write our own stories about going on a hunt for a different animal.

In maths we have been working positional language and we have gone on a bear hunt around school describing the position of all the hidden bears. We have also been looking at sorting and estimating the number of coloured bears and exploring simple number bonds to 10.

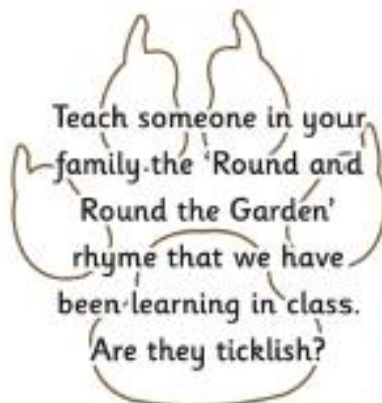
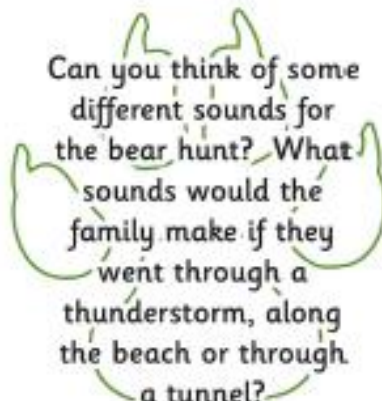
The children really enjoyed investigating what would happen to a gummy bear when it was left overnight in water!
