## **Campout – Friday, 6 July 2018**

On Friday, 6 July there will be a campout for year 6 pupils on the school field. The aim of the event is for the children to have fun!

The event will begin at 6 pm, when children can be dropped off at school. We ask that parents stay to put up tents.

Before and after tea there will be a mixture of rounders and other games, followed by a camp fire.

The main gates of the school will be locked from 10 pm. From approximately 10.30 pm, all children will be in their tents where they can play quiet games and have a midnight feast if they want to.

Parents must arrive to collect their children at 9.30 am the following morning when help dismantling tents and tidying up will be required by everybody.

The cost of the campout is £7.50 per pupil to cover dinner, drinks and breakfast.

Please be reminded that pupils must provide their own tents and names of children in specific tents should be given to school by Wednesday, 5 July. Please note that we cannot provide tents.

As with last year, there will be a team of staff who have kindly given up their time to supervise the children. However, if you could also offer some support in terms of help with catering, the BBQ, making breakfast for the children, **or with donations of wood/logs to burn**, please indicate on the attached pro-forma.

Children attending the campout should bring with them:

- Tent, sleeping bag and sleeping mat
- Pyjamas and dressing gown
- Flip flops/slip on shoes for use in the night if necessary
- Towel, soap, toothbrush
- Warm fleece in case needed
- TORCH
- Games for playing in the tents (eg cards and small board games. Electronic devices or mobile phones are not permitted)
- Midnight feast – please note that no fizzy drinks are allowed in tents. Please remember that no products containing nuts are permitted.

- Swimming kits and trainers
- Change of clothes
- Waterproof coat

Please also note that this is a school activity and normal school rules will still apply. In the event of any unacceptable behaviour by the children, parents will be asked to come and take their child home.

This event is also weather permitting. A final decision will be made on the morning of Friday, 6 July.
